JxRef is a Java code analysis toolset. It is a tool that will help you identify refactoring opportunities in a Java code base. It can also provide information that will help you identify potential risks of making a code change.

JxRef will do the following:

- Identify Sequence diagram information about a method (what it calls in what classes). See [sample](#) (doc/jxref-sequenceFlow.html) .
- Identify application dependencies (on open source projects, for example). See [sample](#) (doc/jxref-methodXref.html) .
- Identify the largest and most complex methods (according to McCabe Complexity metrics). See [sample](#) (doc/jxref-complexity.html) .
